
Minimum Tooth Reduction & Prep Guide


Prep recommendations for the most common restoration types.

IPS e.max® Press 1.5 - 2.0 mm e.max® occlusal or O'Brien Enamelux® Veneer incisal Bonding is necessary to maintain the structural 1.5 mm axial 0.6 mm cervical and labial integrity of the restoration if the occlusal reduction is 1.0 mm less than 1.5 mm. chamfer margin 0.7 mm incisal **Porcelain Porcelain** 1.5 mm occlusal or Labial **Fused to** incisal Margin Metal 1.0 mm 1.5 - 2.0 mm butt joint buccal or The addition of a PLM facial requires prepping the tooth with a 1.0 mm 0.7 mm butt joint. chamfer



All Crowns Containing Ceramic

Make sure there are no sharp edges or corners as those create stress concentration points that can lead to cracks in the material.
